

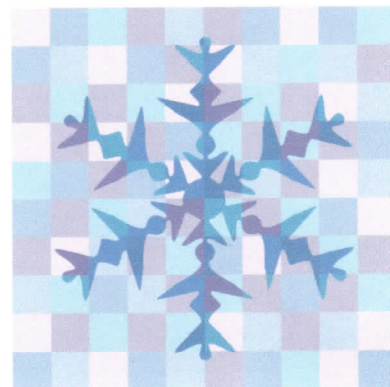

Antenna Bill Reintroduced

Representative Steve Israel (D-NY) has reintroduced a bill designed to give hams living in homeowner-association controlled areas the same right to "reasonable accommodation" of amateur antennas guaranteed by the FCC to other amateurs. The "Amateur Radio Emergency Communications Consistency Act" was introduced in previous sessions of Congress but did not gather enough support to be reported out of committee for a vote on the floor. As the value of amateur radio stations became even more apparent in the aftermath of Hurricane Katrina, Israel decided that the time was ripe to reintroduce the measure. The bill number is HR-3876.
